Dear Parents and 5th Grade Students:

On Friday, June 15, the Bowman fifth grade parents will be holding the end of year celebration: The Luau!. Drinks and snacks will be served (please note there is no pizza or dinner food, and no food or drink may be brought into Clarke by students). A disc jockey will supply music and games in the Clarke cafeteria from 6:00 to 8:00 pm.

All students must enter the building through the gym lobby, where chaperones will be waiting to escort the children to the cafeteria. As with all Clarke social events, **students must arrive no later than 15 minutes after the start of the function, or they will not be allowed entry.** Students will be supervised by parent volunteers and must remain in the cafeteria at all times (except when using the bathrooms). Roaming around the halls or any other area of Clarke will not be allowed. **All rules that apply in school apply at the luau.** Parent chaperones are responsible for ensuring those rules are followed. Any child who is unable to manage their behavior will be given a strike. If a child is given three strikes, they will be removed from the cafeteria, and possibly sent home.

PLEASE BE ON TIME WHEN PICKING UP YOUR STUDENT. Please pick up your child at the Clarke cafeteria, as they will not be allowed to leave the cafeteria until an adult arrives to pick them up. This is to ensure that no children are unsupervised in the parking lot or outside the building.

Thank you for your support in helping your sons and daughters to comply with the above rules. These rules are in place so that everyone can have a fun and safe time.
